



A tax exemption may be granted on account of incurring expenditure on:

establishment of a new plant

increase in the production capacity of an existing plant

purchase of assets belonging to a plant that was closed or would have closed had the purchase not occurred











diversification of the plant's production by introducing products not previously produced in the plant

fundamental change to the production process of an existing plant





Large enterprise plans to invest more than **EUR 100 million**. Income tax exemption will reach **EUR 22.5 million**. In practice, an entrepreneur will be exempted from income tax when starting a new business activity, until the amount of EUR 22.5 million is consumed or until the expiry date of the decision on support (12 years from the date it has been issued, unless the investment is located within the subzone of the PSEZ – Ostrow Island – then up to 15 years).
