

Highways, roads and bridges

America

Sea-to-Sky highway: Advising the Government of British Columbia to design, build, finance, operate and maintain highway improvement project, drafting project documents, Concession Agreement and legal schedules (approx. CA\$600 million).



The biggest urban transport project in Europe:

Susah Secure Port Project: Advising winning sponsors on US\$1.5 billion USD DBOT PPP Concession for Container and Trans-shipment Port in Susah, Libya.

Private Aviation Terminals: Advising PrivatAir Saudi Arabia Limited on the construction, development, operation, administration, management, improvement and maintenance of the existing and new Private Aviation Terminal (PAT) at King Khaled International Airport, Riyadh and King Abdulaziz International Airport, Jeddah in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

PPP for schools in Peru: Advising IFC and the Government of Peru in connection with the structuring and implementation of a public-private partnership for the design, construction, financing and maintenance of up to 41 schools in Lima, Cuzco and elsewhere in Peru.

Intergenerational center in French Guiana:

Advising Agence Française de Développement on a €12 million financing granted to the SCI Le Toucan 973 for the construction and operation of an intergenerational center in French Guiana. This represents the first project financed in France under the EU's "Juncker Plan".

Europe

Four Tuscan hospitals: Appointed by IFI and Government of Uzbekistan to advise on Fergana Oblast Hospitals project, Uzbekistan, a major hospital consolidation PPP.

Dialysis healthcare PPP: Advising the Government of Kyrgyzstan, KfW Development Bank and IFC on a multi-site dialysis healthcare PPP in Kyrgyzstan to provide dialysis treatments across the country – the first such PPP project in the country.

Arena 2 Project: Advising City of Paris on the Arena 2 project. This project consists of the construction of an 8,500 seat arena to host the handball and basketball competitions for the 2024 Olympic Games. This is one of the most significant investment projects for the Paris Olympic Games.

Saclay University PPP: Advising on the 29-year, availability-based PPP DBFM contract of the University's Biology-Pharmacy-Chemistry center, including buildings (total area of approximately 85,000 sqm), as well as the construction of outdoor areas, next to Paris. This is the most important PPP concluded by a University in the past decade.

Sustainable University building: Advising University Witten/Herdecke, Germany's oldest private university on a DBFO contract to develop Germany's most sustainable University building.

District Court in Nowy Sącz: Advising state-owned bank Bank Gospodarstwa Krajowego on Poland's first PPP investment project financing, which involved the design, construction, property management and maintenance services of the head office of the District Court in Nowy Sącz.

Prison in southern Slovakia: Assisting an international energy provider on a subcontracting agreement for the management of a prison facility to be developed as a PPP project. The project involves the development of an 832-detainee prison in Rimavská Sobota, located in southern Slovakia.



La Perla Hydroelectric project: Advising Costa Rican Electricity Institute (ICE) on the construction of a parallel power plant and the ICE to pay compensation, including advising throughout the phases of the plant's construction and operation.

Cap Haitien Port Rehabilitation project:

Advising International Finance Corporation and the Government of Haiti with respect to the structuring and implementation of a PPP for the rehabilitation and operation of the port of Cap Haitien, Haiti.

Water treatment plants: Representing major players in the Mexican water treatment sector in the bidding processes, structuring, implementation and development of the most important water treatment plants in Mexico, including Atotonilco, Agua Prieta, Chihuahua, Ciudad Juarez and Guadalajara.
