

the Future UK/EU Relationship. 15 November: Dominic Raab resigns as Secretary of State for Exiting the European Union and is replaced by Stephen Barclay 25 November: at a special meeting

of the European Council, EU27 leaders endorse the draft Withdrawal Agreement and approve the full draft Political Declaration on Framework for the Future UK/EU relationship.

26 November: the UK government lays the draft Withdrawal Agreement and Political Declaration before Parliament under section 13(1)(a) of the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 8 January: the UK government suffers a Commons defeat over its planning for a no-deal Brexit



11 January: EU governments (represented by the Council of the EU) formally authorise the signing of the Withdrawal Agreement with the aim of sending it to the European Parliament for consent next week

15 January: at the close of the fifth day of debate, MPs reject Theresa May's Withdrawal Agreement by 432 by 202 the biggest loss in modern parliamentary history
