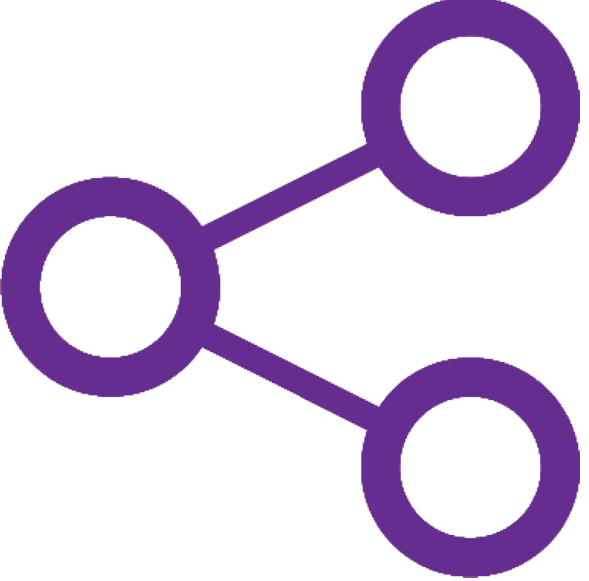

Privacy Notice

Dentons Lopez Velarde, S.C. ("DLV") domiciled at Guillermo Gonzalez Camarena, 1600, 6th floor, Office B, Col. Santa Fe, Delegacion Alvaro Obregon, Federal District, Mexico, considers the protection of your personal data as a transcendental matter; therefore this Privacy Notice, prepared in order to comply with the provisions of the Federal Law of Personal Data Protection, is intended to notify you the personal data

that we gather from you, how and with whom we may share it.

Which personal data do we gather from you?

As a client of some service of ours, representative, officer or employee of our clients, or as counterparty to one of our clients (or representative, officer or employee of such party), we may request from you, personal data that might vary on a case by case basis, related to:

- Your name, address, date of birth.
- Your e-mail address and telephone number.
- Your property information such as bank accounts, loans, goods and real estate, assets, liabilities.
- Information about your spouse, heir, successors or beneficiaries.
- Official documentation in order to evidence your identity and the information that you represent, as well as other identification data as your Federal Taxpayer Registry Number, your personal identity number (CURP).

What do we use your personal data for?

DLV gathers and uses your personal data to achieve the following purposes:

1. Purposes that caused and are necessary to the legal relationship between you and DLV.

- Confirm your identity.
- Understand and handle your legal needs.
- Prepare the documents requested by our clients.
- To render legal advice to you or to our clients.
- Comply with the legal requirements applicable to us.
- Verify the information provided to us.
- To conduct an internal control of the matters entrusted to LVHS which allow us to inform to our clients about the situation and status of those matters.

2. Purposes that did not cause nor are necessary to the legal relationship between you and DLV.

- The promotion of our own services, including the delivery of information about services and events, and also the delivery of our *newsletter*.
- Tax and invoicing purposes.

Likewise, any individual may voluntarily send his/her data (including curricula) to DLV in order to be contacted by us with regards to a possible hiring or to send to the individual information produced by our firm which may be of such individual's interest.

With who and which with purpose do we share your information?

Your personal data are only handled by the personnel of DLV, and as may be required, be shared with our clients, notary publics, accountants, commercial notaries or experts, to analyze the legal situations that are presented to us, advise our clients in such regard, prepare the documents requested by our clients, carry on the proceedings that our clients entrust to us and also for invoicing purposes. Your personal data are not transferred to other third parties unless for the compliance of requirements or legal obligations before authorities with jurisdiction such as public registries, tax authorities as

well as judicial authorities.

How can you limit the use or disclosure of your personal information?

You can limit the use and disclosure of your personal information by means of the following:

How to access, rectify, cancel or oppose to the management of your personal data?

Your brief shall comply with the information and minimum exhibits established in the Federal Law of Personal Data Protection (*name and domicile, copy of a document to evidence your identity, clear and accurate description of the personal data on which some right is intended to be exercised and description of your request.*)
