Overview of the changing ESG supply chain regulatory landscape

ESG supply chain regulation is constantly evolving and will continue to do so. As the need to establish more transparent and sustainable supply chain models grows, here we outline some of the key existing and foreseeable legislation shaping the international ESG supply chain landscape.

Spotlight on the recent German Supply Chain Act

Germany leads the way by imposing new due diligence obligations to safeguard human rights and environmental standards in supply chains. Risks need to be eliminated or at least minimized. We explore implications for organizations operating in Germany (>3,000 employees from 2023, >1,000 from 2024), selling to German customers and for suppliers and sub-suppliers servicing this market.

Craig Woodburn, Head of ESG at Britishvolt and Stephen Carter, Director at Walmart will join us for a lively discussion on how they are strategically approaching, reviewing and adapting their supply chains. This session will focus on the step-change required by all organizations to effectively manage both procedural and on-the-ground risks.
