

Dentons advises Nordic Aviation Capital founder on GIC investment

London —Dentons has advised Martin Møller, the founder of Nordic Aviation Capital (NAC), on Singapore sovereign wealth fund GIC's significant minority investment in NAC.

NAC currently has a fleet of 480 aircraft with a value of USD\$8.3 billion. Martin Møller and EQT VI formed a partnership in 2015 which has since transformed NAC from being a lessor focused on turboprop aircraft, to being the world's largest regional aircraft lessor and the fourth largest commercial aircraft leasing company.

GIC is a global investor with significant aircraft leasing experience and the transaction will be executed by an affiliate of GIC.
