A personal data breach occurs when the data that we process, store or we are responsible for is mishandled as a result of noncompliance with data security rules, leading to loss of confidentiality, destruction or unauthorized disclosure of or access to personal data.

A company data breach can happen as a result of a cyberattack, but – in practice – it is more often due to human failure. Every such breach, regardless of cause, could mean that in-house security procedures or measures that are in place in the company are inadequate. The consequences of data leakage can go far beyond in-house appraisals of data mishandling, and might potentially result in discrimination, identity theft, fraud, financial detriment and reputational harm, which could inflict more damage on the company than any fine imposed by the personal data protection authority.
