

# Dentons continues to climb in the *Chambers Europe* rankings

*Chambers Europe* 2021 has recognized 192 Dentons lawyers as leaders in their fields across 17 jurisdictions in Europe and the UK, as well as in the CEE and Europe-wide categories. This year, Dentons received 20 new and 21 improved lawyer rankings.

Of an overall 222 lawyer rankings, 79 are within the top echelon (Band 1 and 2). *Chambers Europe* awarded eight Dentons lawyers the 'Eminent Practitioner' status, reflecting their long-term leadership and influence within the legal profession. In addition, the directory recognized Dentons' young talent – with 13 lawyers awarded in the 'Up and Coming' and 'Associates to Watch' categories.

Dentons received 135 practice and sector rankings, of which 31 were in Band 1 and 29 were in Band 2. The Firm earned 16 new or improved practice rankings. These include an improved position in the Europe-wide Corporate/ M&A and Tax categories, reflecting Dentons' significant cross-border capabilities and its strategy to be a leading pan-European law firm.

The *Chambers Europe* guide identifies the top lawyers and law firms in 52 jurisdictions across Europe and ranks them based on in-depth research and feedback from clients and peers.
